

Long-Sharp Gallery presents a two-part exhibition at Treasure House Fair 2026

A dialogue across generations — from Warhol and Bourgeois to a new generation of women artists redefining contemporary practice

Indianapolis, IN – 22 April 2026 – Long-Sharp Gallery is pleased to announce its presentation at London’s Treasure House Fair 2026, taking place 24-30 June on the South Grounds of the Royal Hospital Chelsea. The gallery’s two-part exhibition in Stand 104 moves between blue-chip modern masters and a focused curatorial statement on contemporary women artists working at the forefront of their fields.

Part One: A Conversation Across Eras

The first presentation brings together a constellation of artists whose work spans the twentieth and twenty-first centuries, united by an insistence on formal rigor and expressive range. Works by Andy Warhol, Joan Mitchell, Louise Bourgeois, Lee Krasner, Bridget Riley, and Anni Albers anchor the presentation, placing Pop, Abstract Expressionism, Op Art, and Bauhaus-rooted textile practice in sustained dialogue. Joining them are David Spiller, whose narrative-driven imagery bridges street culture and art history; Tarik Currimbhoy, known for his steel kinetic sculptures; and Chul Hyun Ahn, whose immersive light installations interrogate perception and space.

Part Two: The Present Is Female

In *The Present Is Female: A Reckoning*, Long-Sharp Gallery brings together seven contemporary women artists with ties to the UK: Moira Cameron, Julia Ibbini, Yulia Brodskaya, Nicola Anthony, Fiona Grady, Cecily Brown, and Tacita Dean. Each artist brings a distinct material language — from Brodskaya's quilled paper compositions to Anthony's sculptural assemblages to Ibbini's algorithmically informed geometric work — forming a collective argument for the vitality and diversity of women-led practices today. The presentation is deepened by the inclusion of original prints by Cecily Brown and Tacita Dean, two artists of international stature whose work expands the exhibition's conversation across painting, film, and drawing.

Together, the two presentations reflect Long-Sharp Gallery's sustained commitment to exhibitions that are both intellectually rigorous and visually alive — work that rewards close looking and resists easy categorization.
